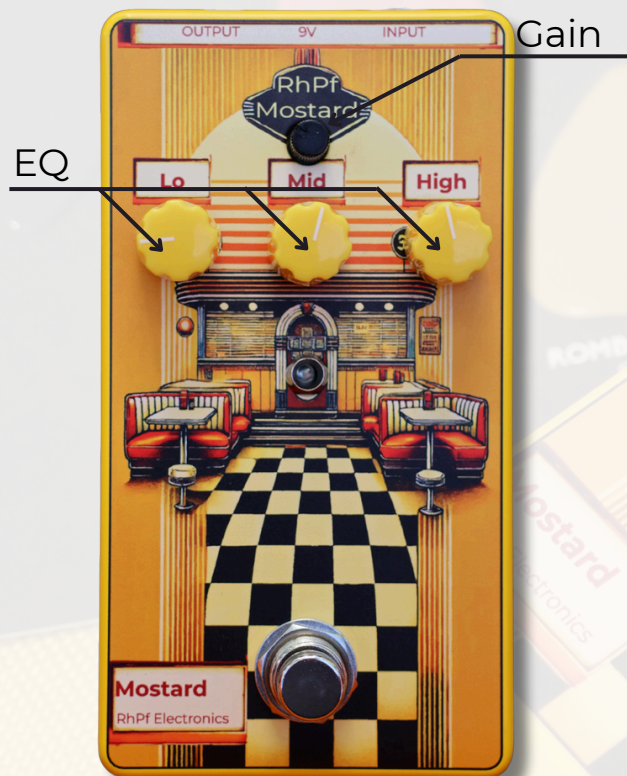


Mostard



Controls

- Gain: Clean boost with increasing treble as you turn it up.
- Low: Shapes the bottom from lean to transparent, never muddy
- Mid: Smooths out boxiness or adds clarity and bite
- High: Adds sparkle or tames the top end with finesse

Mostard isn't your average clean boost. It brings clarity, energy, and a naturally bright voice that snaps your tone into focus, like a dash of Texas hot sauce. With up to +30 dB of clean gain and a custom-voiced EQ, it lifts your playing with definition and drive, whether you're sculpting rhythm or spotlighting a solo.

From Dijon to Drive

Born from a joke and inspired by real heat, Mostard blends the sting of Dijon mustard with the bite of Texas tone. It's bold, unapologetic, and designed to push your amp, pedals, or mix just enough to stand out, never harsh, always alive. It's clean, but with flavor. Just like the condiment it's named after, a little goes a long way.

Bright by Nature

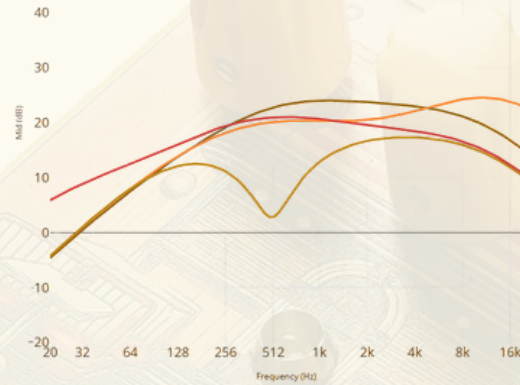
Mostard was never meant to stay neutral. Its voice leans naturally toward presence and sparkle, especially in the upper mids. Even low settings sound crisp and alert. As you turn up the gain, it adds treble-forward focus, perfect for cutting through without crowding the mix.

Shaped to Fit

The 3-band EQ isn't about extremes, it's about refinement. The low control tightens boom without thinning. The mids clear out boxiness or add bite. The highs offer either shimmer or smoothness, depending on your rig. It's all voiced to serve your guitar, not fight it.

Boost That Wakes Up Gear

With clean amps, Mostard adds shape and immediacy. Into breakup, it sharpens response. Into fuzz or distortion, it adds edge and articulation without overloading the chain. It's not just louder, it's more alive.



Dynamic but Defined

The gain control is placed after the core gain stage, meaning you get full output control without dragging unwanted low-end mud with it. And because of how it interacts with the circuit, pushing the gain actually adds clarity, not flub.



Final Polish Included

Before it hits the output, a last-stage filter quietly balances the tone, trimming harshness, smoothing lows, and making sure Mostard plays nicely with whatever comes next. It's subtle, but it makes a difference in every setup.



Always On, or Ready to Rip

Some players leave it on all the time for that "plugged-in" feel. Others kick it in for solos, sparkle, or breakup. Either way, Mostard delivers spice and style without taking over. Clean, bold, and confident, this boost doesn't blend in. It steps up.
