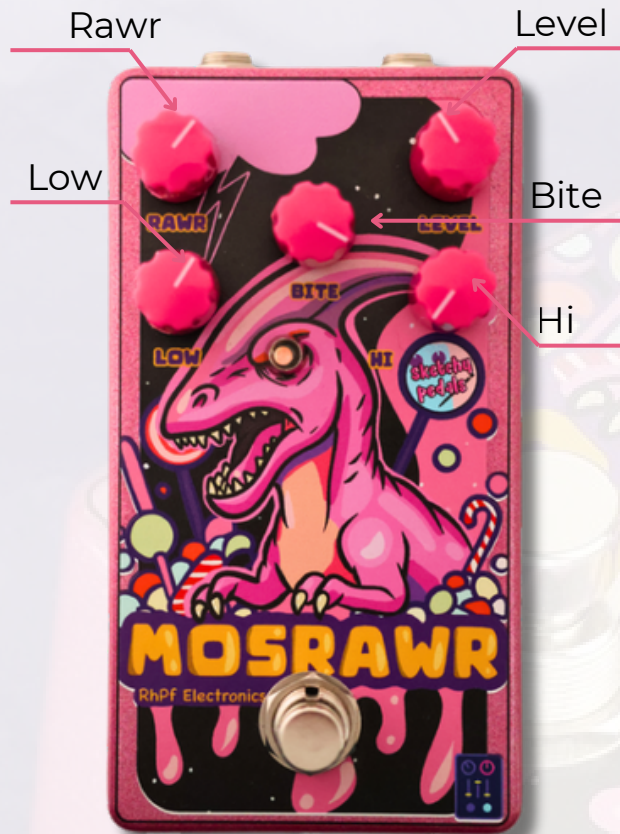


# Mosrawr



## Controls

- Rawr: From gritty saturation to full-blown fuzz avalanche.
- Low: Adds low-end mass and body.
- Bite: Shapes the growl and focus of the gain core.
- Hi: Brightens texture, from sticky grind to open air.
- Level: Sets the overall output volume.

## The Velcro Roar

Mosrawr is fuzz made flesh: Raw, sticky, alive. Its multi-stage MOSFET core growls with low-mid weight and a velcro bite that clings to every note. Built for texture and movement, it thrives where chaos meets control.

## Built with Loopy Demos & Sketchy Pedals

Born from Loopy Demos' push for wilder tone and Sketchy Pedals' pastel creature design, Mosrawr bridges aggression and playfulness.

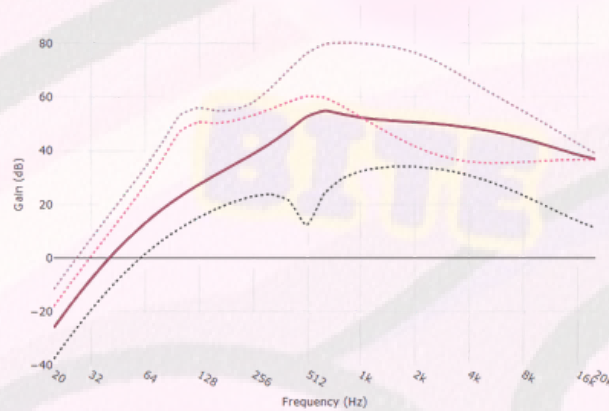

## Low-Mid Muscle

At the heart of Mosravr lies its desert-hungry midrange. It's tuned around the frequency where guitars roar, not rumble. Push the Mid control and you'll feel the growl tighten; pull it back and the fuzz breathes, letting layers spread into open air.



## Texture That Clings

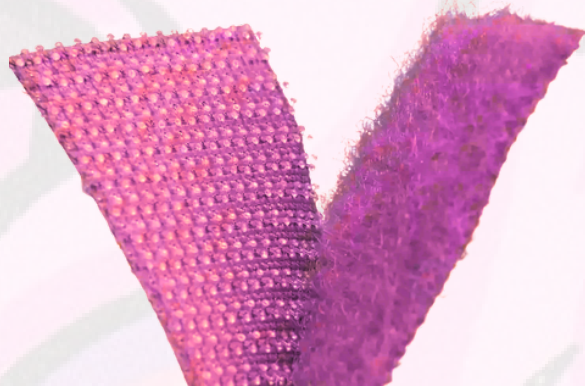
Mosravr's fuzz feels physical, like tearing fabric. It reacts to your attack, wrapping notes in a velcro grind that stretches and snarls. Every turn of the Bass and Treble reshapes the edges, from sticky compression to wide, airy sludge.

## Control and Collapse

The gain core walks a fine line between order and chaos. Keep it balanced for articulate walls of fuzz, or crank it until it teeters on the edge of self-oscillation. It will hold shape as long as you let it, then joyfully implode.

## Built for Stacks

Shoegaze. Noise rock. Post-rock. Mosravr was made for layers. It thrives with delay and reverb, building a huge, breathing mass of tone that stays defined even when drenched in effects. The sustain hangs endlessly, each note melting into the next.



## Touch and Reaction

Behind the aggression, Mosravr remains alive and sensitive. Roll your guitar volume down, and the roar softens into grainy drive; hit it harder, and it swells into a wall of harmonics. It's a living texture that follows your hands.



## A Fuzz with a Bite

Built entirely around MOSFET dynamics, Mosravr transforms distortion into motion. It doesn't just amplify, it breathes, shivers, and growls back. Every sound feels massive, but never static. This is fuzz that moves.
